- diagnose a motorcycle vehicle,
- assess the technical condition of motorcycle vehicles,
- repair motorcycle vehicles,
- ride and operate motorcycles,
- use technical documentation,

and additionally, within the scope of the professional tasks performed:

observe occupational health and safety regulations, fire safety and environmental protection regulations and requirements of ergonomics;

- provide first aid to the injured in accidents at work and in health and life-threatening situations,
- apply legal provisions relating to the conduct of business activity, labour law, copyrights law and personal data protection law,
- communicate in a foreign language in the performance of professional tasks.
